

Beginner's checklist for Paintball in Biberach

Here is a summary of the most important things that every beginner, or experienced player who wants to play with us, should consider:

- The **original identity card**, **passport** or **driver's license** (from any country) must be brought along and produced on-site! If you do not have one of these documents with you, you **CANNOT** participate in the game. **We won't make any exceptions!**
- ✓ Paintball is **NOT** a war game. Paintball is a team sport with a comprehensive set of rules, just like other sports.
- For this reason, the wearing of any kind of **camouflage clothing** and/or the like **is prohibited** in our hall. If you can't bring a "sporty outfit", you can also reach for old jeans and a washed-out sweatshirt. Please consider that **all parts of the body should be covered**.
- We also recommend bringing knee pads, gloves, a baseball cap and, if available, genital protection. Please also bring a scarf or shawl for the neck. Chest protectors for women can be provided upon request, free of charge.
- ✓ The minimum playing age in Germany is 18 years. Minors are neither permitted to stay nor to play in the company of adults.
- ✓ **Spectators are allowed**, which means that not everyone *has* to play. As noted above, please remember that the minimum age for staying with us is 18 years.
- ✓ Wearing contact lenses instead of glasses is recommended (due to the mask), but not mandatory.
- Paintball is different. Completely different from everything else. Therefore: be sure to bring your camera! A professional photo service can be booked optionally.
- ✓ Payment is possible in cash or by EC card. No credit cards.
- ✓ **Alcohol** or the consumption of **other drugs** is **prohibited** before and during the paintball event and in our hall. Anyone who is visibly drunk must leave the Paintball Area premises without discussion.
